**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING A CHANGE IN MAXIMUM
ALLOWABLE PUMPING FEES**

WHEREAS, the mission of the Fox Canyon Groundwater Management Agency includes the protection and preservation of the groundwater resources within the boundaries of the Fox Canyon Groundwater Management Agency, and;

WHEREAS, Chapter 121 of the State Water Code limits the maximum amount that the Fox Canyon Groundwater Management Agency can charge for pumping to \$3.00 per acre-foot, and;


WHEREAS, the maximum fees allowable were established at a time when the groundwater pumpers in the Fox Canyon Groundwater Management Agency pumped approximately 160,000 acre-feet per year, and;

WHEREAS, the average amount of groundwater now pumped is approximately 120,000 acre-feet per year, and;

WHEREAS, the cost of running the Agency could have been supported when 160,000 acre-feet per year was pumped, it cannot be supported at the current pumping level;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that the Agency Coordinator take those actions necessary to change West's Annotated California Code – Water Appendix, Chapter 121-1007 to allow a pumping fee range with a maximum of ten dollars (\$10.00) per acre-foot per year. Actual fees are to be set within the allowable range by Resolution of the Board of Directors.

On motion by Director Fox, and seconded by Director Mikos, the foregoing resolution was passed and adopted on December 17, 2003.
