WHEREAS, seismic refraction equipment is available that can provide the subsurface geological information that is presently unknown, and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Water Resources is offering a grant under the Local Groundwater Management Assistance Act of 2000;



RESOLUTION 04-1
of the
FOX CANYON GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT AGENCY

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDING FROM THE STATE
OF CALIFORNIA FOR GROUNDWATER STUDIES**

WHEREAS, the Fox Canyon Groundwater Management Agency (FCGMA) has implemented procedures to manage each groundwater basin separately but requires additional funding if available to accomplish planned goals, and

WHEREAS, it is clear that specific basin management is in the best interests of the Agency and the groundwater aquifers, as well as the local land owners, and

WHEREAS, each groundwater basin has unique characteristics and hydrology that can be better understood with more accurate geophysical and hydrological data, and

WHEREAS, the landowners, well owners, and water providers have all agreed to assist in groundwater studies on or beneath their properties, and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Water Resources has Proposition 50 funds available through a Local Groundwater Assistance grant program pursuant to the Local Groundwater Management Assistance Act of 2000 (Water Code Section 10795 *et seq.*), which might be used to accomplish local resource management goals, and

WHEREAS, the FCGMA has limited funding from extraction charges and all well operators within the Agency should have their required groundwater extraction fee payments supplemented whenever possible to help pay for studies and programs that benefit everyone,

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby proclaimed and ordered that the Agency Coordinator shall act as the official FCGMA representative, and is thus authorized and directed to prepare the necessary data, make investigations, execute, and file such application and agreement with California Department of Water Resources to accept the available grant if obtained. DWR funds shall be used for the purpose of conducting groundwater basin studies and/or groundwater management activities.
