Fox Canyon Groundwater Management Agency

A RESOLUTION INCREASING THE GROUNDWATER EXTRACTION CHARGE
TO \$4.00 PER ACRE-FOOT

WHEREAS, the Fox Canyon Groundwater Management Agency desires to change the groundwater extraction charge for those extraction facilities located within the boundary of the Fox Canyon Groundwater Management Agency; and

WHEREAS, the groundwater extraction charge now in effect is not expected to provide the necessary contingency for litigation potentially required during the next calendar year, and;

WHEREAS, The increase in extraction charge will be reduced before July 1, 2005, if the increase is found to be unnecessary due to finalization of 2004 income or settlement of any legal issues, and;

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 2734 (Strickland, 2004) granted the Board of Directors of the Fox Canyon Groundwater Management Agency the authority to levy a groundwater extraction charge not to exceed six dollars (\$6.00) per acre-foot extracted per year.


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that effective January 1, 2005, the groundwater extraction charge shall be four dollars (\$4.00/AF) per acre-foot for groundwater extracted from facilities within the boundary of the Fox Canyon Groundwater Management Agency.

On motion by Director Flynn, seconded by Director Schwabauer, the foregoing Resolution was passed and adopted on December 15, 2004.
