**A RESOLUTION**

**SETTING SURCHARGE RATES**

**WHEREAS, there is a clear need to bring the groundwater basins within the Fox Canyon Groundwater Management Agency into safe yield, and since current and future demand will be dependent upon reliable and steady water sources for a continuous supply to ensure safe and marketable water; and**

**WHEREAS, the existing surcharge penalty rates are not sufficient to deter overpumping or excessive groundwater extractions when compared to alternative retail water rates; and**

**WHEREAS, an economic incentive is deemed the best means to control groundwater use or discourage overpumping; and**

**WHEREAS, it has been expressed by the Agency members that a single penalty or surcharge rate is preferable and less confusing than a tiered or incremental schedule; and**

**WHEREAS, Ordinance 5.7 provides for setting surcharge rates by resolution.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that a new surcharge rate of \$725 per acre-foot shall be levied on all groundwater extractions in excess of the combined allocation for all water wells within the Agency.**


**Payments shall be due and payable within 30 days of the date the confirmation of credit form is postmarked. This Resolution shall take effect on January 1, 1999, and may be subject to change at any time by the Fox Canyon GMA Board of Directors.**

**On motion by Director Flynn, seconded by Director Conroy, the foregoing resolution was passed and adopted this 28<sup>th</sup> DAY OF OCTOBER 1998.**


