A RESOLUTION

**COMMENDING THE PORT HUENEME WATER AGENCY
FOR THE BRACKISH WATER RECLAMATION FACILITY**

WHEREAS, the waters of the County of Ventura are one of the County's most precious natural resources; and

WHEREAS, the Fox Canyon Groundwater Management Agency is dedicated to the preservation and protection of groundwater within the boundary of the Agency; and

WHEREAS, the Port Hueneme Water Agency Brackish Water Reclamation Facility will enhance the objectives of the Fox Canyon Groundwater Management Agency; and

WHEREAS, the Port Hueneme Water Agency has exhibited vision and leadership in the area of water supply and quality by promoting the role of desalination technologies which support the Fox Canyon Groundwater Management Agency's strategy to protect and preserve local groundwater supplies; and

WHEREAS, the Port Hueneme Water Agency successfully partnered with the United States Bureau of Reclamation and successfully obtained a \$3.7 million dollar Federal investment in support of this Brackish Water Reclamation Facility.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that the Port Hueneme Water Agency be highly commended for the future vision, dedication to preserve local groundwater resources, and for the perseverance necessary to complete this unique and valuable facility.

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
