INCREASING EXTRACTION CHARGES
TO \$2.60 PER ACRE-FOOT


WHEREAS, the Fox Canyon Groundwater Management Agency desires to change the groundwater extraction charge for those extraction facilities located within the boundary of the Fox Canyon Management Agency; and

WHEREAS, the groundwater extraction charge now in effect will not provide the funding necessary operating funds beginning next fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, Deering's Water Uncodified Acts, Act 2670, Section 10 as amended, grants the Board of Directors of the Fox Canyon Groundwater Management Agency the authority to levy groundwater extraction charges up to three dollars (\$3.00) per acre-foot per year.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that effective January 1, 1999, the groundwater extraction charge shall be two dollars and sixty cents (\$2.60) per acre-foot for groundwater extracted from facilities within the boundary of the Fox Canyon Groundwater Management Agency.

On motion by Director Flynn, seconded by Director Tingstrom, the foregoing resolution was passed and adopted on this 2nd DAY OF DECEMBER 1998.




